<b>NADERE TOELICHTING</b>	
<p>At the Faculty of Archaeology (FA), a number of incidents related to issues of authorship occurred in recent years call for an explicit set of guidelines. A basic set of Faculty co-authorship guidelines, applicable to ‘humanities’, ‘heritage’ and ‘science’ types of archaeological research, has been designed. These guidelines are a tool, designed for Faculty of Archaeology staff, aiming to ‘protect and empower’ (junior) researchers when discussing and negotiating co-authorship issues with senior staff and external (co-authoring) partners. It is recommended to act in the spirit of the Faculty guidelines, even when participating in a publication initiated by an external party.</p> <p>See the attached document for more information.</p>
